Matured in French and American oak (27% new) for 14 months. A very well made, medium-bodied wine, supple and long with high quality fruit its foundation, although oak had a hand in its élevage. It points the way for Prodigy in coming years. 94 Points. Drink by 2035.

Mostly matured in aged French oak though 10% sees new American oak. Super sweet flavour profile. It comes across as simple as a result. Raspberry coulis and vanilla-cream with orange Tang and red licorice inflections. It's fresh and lively, no doubt, though this is more wine-and-coke territory than dry table wine.

Cola, clove and nutmeg, followed by small hints of ash/smoke, raspberry, blue plum and sweaty blue meat. Fruit generous palate full of small dark berries supported by firm tannins. American oak creates extra sweetness that distracts slightly. Tangy finish, medium in length. Ready go now for those that like a plush ride.

A beautiful Shiraz from renowned Cabernet country. So often everything else in Coonawarra gets overlooked but here's yet another example of what the region can do so well. Baked raspberry, red plums, plus scents of clove. Some black fruit to taste adds another level of interest. A shimmer of spice makes enough noise to be the mouth fills out well from this full-bodied delight. An ever so slight mint character peers through but the dark fruits jostle it back in to place with bitter chocolate to finish. Although three years old now, this will unfurl well for a decade or more.
