Review

Katnook Estate Chardonnay 2018 is pale gold with green tinges. It has rich fruit aromas of white peach, ripe pear and citrus with subtle vanilla and cashew nuts. The palate is complex with flavours of stone fruit flavours and hints of citrus. Made from rich, full flavoured fruit with subtle oak complexity, this wine will age for up to 10 years if you can wait that long.

The 2018 Chardonnay is so fresh, and citrus driven at the moment, that you'll be rewarded if you have the patience to put some in the cellar for a few years. In the glass its pale-yellow shade with lovely stone fruit and spiced citrus notes coming through on the nose plus some lovely oaky vanilla butter also. In the mouth its crisp and clean with plenty of body and a nice long finish.

Yellow peach, whipped butter and vanilla cream. Touches of lemon add flare on a full and moreish wine. A rich example of Chardonnay which certainly walks with a strong presence. A slippery feel closes out the finish. Drink to six years.
